

Michael Bolton Platinum Club Ticket Policy

MBPC Ticket Availability

- Whenever possible, preferred tickets will be made available for sale to current members prior to being available to the general public.
- Seat locations will not be available ahead of time but all seats should be located within the contract specifications of 1st-15th row.
- MBPC purchasing is planned to close 7 days prior to the tickets going on sale to the general public.
- The MBPC will work with the venue to insure consecutive seating arrangements as desired. However, as the seating arrangements are not in the control of the MBPC, no guarantees can be given concerning seating arrangements.
- MBPC tickets are being handled by the MBPC, hence the venues are not able to address issues related to these tickets. Again, please visit the web site for up-to-date information.

MBPC Ticket Pricing & Purchasing

- You must be a MBPC or Gold Club (until June 30) member to purchase tickets. Orders from non members will not be processed.
- MBPC members will be allowed to purchase 4 tickets per event. Gold Club members will be able to purchase 2 tickets per event (until June 30th).
- Tickets will be sold for face value + a processing fee of \$3.50 per ticket. There is also an additional fee for shipping which will run \$6 US and Canada and approximately \$18 for International per order. Due to the value of these tickets, and the critical nature of prompt delivery. We use these services as it allows both the customer and the company to track the package until it is in the members' hands. Tickets will not be shipped to P.O. Boxes. When tickets are shipped, members will be e-mailed their tracking number if an e-mail address has been provided and specific delivery date.
- MBPC member payment for tickets will be with a major credit card (Visa, Am Ex, Master Card) or money order made out to Michael Bolton Platinum Club.
- Lost or stolen tickets cannot be replaced. The MBPC does not offer refunds for tickets.
- In the event of a cancellation, refunds are subject to the policy of the venue.

Ticket Processing

- Email, fax or mail your name, address that corresponds to your credit card being used, address to ship tickets (if different than credit card address), phone number, credit card (Visa,, Master Card, Amex), expiration date, number of tickets ordering (up to 4 for Platinum Club members and 2 for Gold Club members), which venue you are ordering tickets for and your e-mail address. Please fax this information to the Michael Bolton Platinum Club at (973) 316-0323, e-mail it to info@michaelboltonclub.com or mail this information along with your credit card info or a money order made out to Michael Bolton Platinum Club (not a check) to MBPlatinum Tickets, P.O. Box 177, Boonton, NJ 07005.
- There is no need to send copies of your membership cards since you are purchasing through the fan club. Only member orders will be processed.


